

SELECTBOARD MEETING MINUTES
November 4, 2013

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Announcements- Kevin announced a showing of a documentary film, After the Flood, at the Depot building at 7:00 on Thursday, November 14.

Also, the first issue of the revitalized Londonderry Monthly is out.

Pay orders were signed.

Animal Control Officer- Pat Salo was in to discuss complaints of barking dogs in the Magic Circle area. The worst barking offenders are moving in a couple of weeks, so he feels the situation will be resolved at that time.

The board will follow up with the person making the original complaint.

Beavers on Mtn. Lake Road- The board asked Pat to trap the beavers that are plugging a culvert there.

After the Flood task force- Sharon explained that the group wants to make maximum effort to get the word out to the public about the upcoming informational meeting on November 21. They want to put out a mailing to the voter checklist for the event, as well purchasing some refrigerator magnets for a more lasting reminder of the effort and website. The Planning Commission has money in their budget that could cover the cost of these items.

A motion was made and unanimously passed to approve up to \$1000 expenditure for the two items.

Londonderry Monthly- Sharon mentioned that the first edition of the new Londonderry Monthly is out. It will be distributed electronically via the website and the town's listserv. Printed copies of it will be distributed as well.

Wall mural in the north village- Garrison Buxton is still interested in doing a project. He would welcome more feedback about what people would like to see. The board made a few suggestions about color and design.

Park Board items- The old playground structure was taken down today.

Minutes of the October 21 meeting were approved and signed.

Roads and bridges-

Duane handed out to the board some informational materials that he has received at various classes, including winter maintenance, right of ways, and trees.

Duane urges that the town should have a Winter Roads Plan. We will work on that.

The dump body on the '02 Mack should be done this week. Hal Coleman worked on the International dump body this week.

Duane is working on an RFP for chloride.

The culvert inventory is almost completed.

Transfer Station- Steve Prouty has offered to do some fill in when needed. The board verified that he should be paid as an employee when he does.

Old business-

Fiscal year change- The board finalized a decision to not make the fiscal year change in 2014. No action was needed.
