There is \$250.00 available from the Canopy Grant with a match of \$250.00. Irwin Kuperberg will look into purchasing a GPS device with these funds for the purpose of the Ash Tree Inventory. The other option is planting more trees in town. Irwin will check with Kathie regarding the specifics of the grant. .

**New Business**

Margie Beckwith attended the meeting as an interested new LCC board member.

A discussion was held on solar panels and outdoor wood burning units regarding the public concern about the visual and environmental impact. As of now anyone can put up panels without zoning. Wood burning units create a lot of smoke. It was suggested that this issue is not within the purview of LCC but will remain on the radar.

Mark Wright will notify the Select board with recommendations for the new members of the LCC.

The number of commission members will be discussed at next month's meeting as well as other ways for town lands to be maintained e.g. sheep grazing.
