Administrative Matters

Old Business

Summer butterfly session was held and it was very well attended.

The milkweed has been planted at the Prouty land.

Kathie Stone will contact Mark Wright to complete the paperwork for the Canopy grant that needs to be submitted by the end of July 2016.

The discussion of the Natural Resources and Land Conservation section of the current town plan was tabled until the August 2016 meeting.

HOMEWORK: read the Natural Resources and Land Conservation section so it can be discussed at the next meeting.

The Planning Commission would like to hold a joint meeting with the Conservation Commission to discuss changes to the current Town Plan. A tentative date of September 12, 2016 has been set.

Irwin Kuperberg will ask for the results of the public meeting regarding the Town Plan that was held this past spring.

Margie Beckwith will ask the Londonderry Historical Society if there is data on the historical and agricultural lands in Londonderry.

The LCC should attend select board meeting to find out what is being planned for the Prouty Land.

The LCC read the "Powers and duties of conservation commission" which is published by the Associations of Vermont Conservation Commissions.

New Business

There has been an elevated E.coli reading at the water sampling site near Rowe's Road South Londonderry. The upper portion as it flows through town is normal.

Wildlife – fox, deer, turkey, ducks, chipmunks, woodchuck, snake, squirrel, blue jays
