

**Londonderry Conservation Commission**  
**Minutes**

**July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2014**

**Administration Matters:**

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. Members present: Mark Wright, Bob Trask, Irwin Kuperberg, Kathie Stone and Bob Twitchell.

The minutes of the June meeting were reviewed and corrected a motion was made to accept the minutes by Kathie Stone with a second by Bob Twitchell. The motion passed.

Bob Twitchell gave the Treasurer's report and advised the commission that the balance in the Conservation fund at the end of the second quarter was \$14,756.26. He also reported that he had given the \$2000.00 check for the Norr right of way to the Town Treasurer and requested a check made out to the Londonderry Conservation fund so that it could be deposit in the Conservation fund.

**Old Business:**

Kathie Stone reported that she had been working on the LCC pages for the Town website and had forward some sample pages to Paul for his comments and is waiting to hear back from him.

Mark Wright reported that that the Norr closing had taken place and that he had no additional information other than Twitchell's report of the check discussed in the Treasurer's report.

**New Business:**

Irwin Kuperberg reported that the Wildlife photo of the month was of two Moose seen in his field.

Kuperberg also reported that he posted the water test results in the following locations: Village Pantry, Clarks IGA and the Post Office. He stated that the reports had been abnormal only after heavy rain fall and that e coli levels were not elevated during dry periods.

Commission members discussed standard operating procedures and a motion was made by Irwin Kuperberg to amend the procedures as follows: add the election of a Vice Chair, vote to join the Woodland Owners Association each year and to require that if any member had three unannounced absences in the period of one year the member shall resign. The motion was seconded by Kathy Stone and the motion carried.

Commission members decided to add an new agenda item to each agenda posted : Visitors and Concerned Citizens is now to be listed monthly on the agenda under new business.

**Other:**

Mark Wright invited Commission members to visit Haven Hill Farm and see the land his family recently put in the Vermont Land Trust at 5pm prior to the August meeting.

**Wildlife:**

Bobolinks, Black bear, Moose, Woodchuck, American Bittern, Ruffed grouse, Deer, Snapping Turtles, Cooper Hawk, Blue Heron, Fox and King Fisher .

Irwin Kuperberg made a motion to adjourn at 7:45 p.m. Kathy Stone seconded the motion. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
