Administrative Matters

The minutes of February 18, 2016 were approved.

Bob Twitchell reported that there is \$18858.24 in the Conservation Fund. A donation for \$50.00 was received and with a motion from Helen Hamman and a second from Margie Beckwith it was decided that the donation will be deposited into the Conservation Fund.

Old Business

The LCC will continue to monitor any new developments regarding the Emerald Ash Borer.

Margie Beckwith reported that the likely presenters for the Pond Event will be Lori Peacoat and Jolene Hamilton. Lorri Peacoat will show a power point presentation on shore land and aquatic habitat of ponds. Jolene Hamilton will speak on invasive plant control and stocking fish to obtain a healthy pond habitat. Margie Beckwith will propose a tentative date of May 18th to the presenters. The advertising for the event will be decided at the next LCC meeting

We are awaiting a response from Marie Caduto regarding the water testing in Weston.

Summer butterfly session will be discussed at the next meeting.

Woolly Adelgid reports were turned in and will be mailed to Jim Esden.

The Town of Londonderry approved the SeVWA Funding Request at the Town meeting in the amount \$415.00

The LCC is contributing \$1500.00 to SeVWA from the operating budget. Bob Twitchell will request that town treasurer send a check.

Helen Hamman will order milkweed to plant on the hillside across from Clark's.
