1. Meeting was called to order at 7:14 PM by Danny Cobb, chair.
2. There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.
3. **Minutes** of last meeting, Feb. 5, 2015. Approved. (Gary moved, Laurie seconded.)

- Laurie will put into *The Message* re: cleaning up the cemeteries by Saturday, April 25<sup>th</sup>. Cemeteries are normally officially open May 1. (Duane and Melissa will communicate to Laurie the official date to have graves cleaned off for future reference).

Gary wondered about paving in Riverside. Yes, that is the plan for this year. Just the main loop.

Sullivan's property has sold (borders Glebeview). A little more clean up still needs to be done. Discussion re: fence going up. Danny Cobb will call the new owners of that property.

One burial coming up, Riverside. Duane is not certain if it will be a full burial or cremation.

Headstones are currently being made by Fenton & Hennessey for (Wade and Alexander).

**8. Sale of cemetery plots**

**9. Old Business**

Melvin has ordered the flags and the poles.

Gary will contact Courtney Barton re: Girl Scouts putting flags in.

Discussion re: asking Cub Scouts. No decision reached re: asking them

- Laurie will also put into the paper that we request that there be no new in-ground planters and no fences around the stones.

**10. New business**

Stone wall portion of Glebeview. The boundary line is five feet on the *other* side of the stone wall, so that brush can be cut.

Lowell Lake, needs a new fence and needs new fence post. Path up to cemetery will be trimmed.

New fence at Glebeview will be six inches off the ground so that it can be trimmed underneath.

Discussion re: throwing old flowers over the fences at Glebeview and Riverside.

**11. Adjournment.** Laurie moved that we adjourn, Gary seconded. Motion passed.

Adjournment was at 8:00 PM.
