Memorial Park Trustees' Meeting Minutes

The group met to discuss maintenance issues and ongoing projects at the park. The overall consensus is the Park has been kept relatively clean since removing garbage barrels and adopting the Pack In / Pack Out Policy. The water appears to be cleaner with the use of our water treatments. The storms that occurred during the week of the July 4th Holiday damaged one of the boards controlling the water pumps. Frost Wells was contacted to replace it. The water level has dropped about 12" without the pumps running. Since the water is low, signage will be placed to notify swimmers not to dive.

2 new ladders have been purchased and will be installed on the swim platforms. Water Depth Markers will be installed on the swim platforms. The park is asking for sand toy donations that can be left at the park for children to play with. Julie Snide is donating a wooden bin to store the items.

The permit for the Memorial Park sign is being resubmitted for approval. The location will be in the front entrance near the guard rail.

A work list was compiled for the volunteers of Serve if they can fit it into their schedule. Weeding, trimming and, building a message board, cleaning out the bath houses and redressing the lower handicap road and creating a turnaround were some of the suggestions.

The Trustees decided not to dismantle the existing bath houses and decided to focus on refurbishing the existing structures and bring them up to date.
