Draft Minutes June 21, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 4:31.

The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Changes were unanimously voted for the agenda. Item #6 & #9 Stumping and grading, power installation update were removed from the agenda. The Williams Park picnic tables were added.

It was unanimously voted to move Dog rules and tennis ahead on the agenda since the planning commission was not available yet.

Kelly agreed to handle getting a sign permit for the Dog Rule Sign. The road crew agreed to install the rule sign and the waste disposal station.

Wendy said she would call Jeff from West River Tennis club to ask who he would have helping out with the kids at tennis camp. There are not currently enough kids signed up to hold tennis camp.

There was a long discussion with the Planning commission about the plans for the Baccash and Barker/Morris buyout properties. The only change to the Baccash property was to remove the bench. The changes that were discussed for the Barker/Morris property were removing the bench and signage, not adding additional parking space beyond the gravel area that already exists, using green space as a delinieation between the Carlton and Barker property instead of stone and not creating any path ways but allowing the naturally worn paths as they are.

Plans for family fun were discussed. Wendy Arace motioned to approve a \$50.00 deposit to go to Jump fore fun for two bouncy houses. Pam seconded the motion. The motion passed. Everyone is going to start organizing the event.

The issue of closing the gate at night was discussed. It was agreed we would try leaving it open as long as there were no problems occurring after reasonable operating hours. Kelly made the motion to get three game cameras to help with the vandalism issues that have reoccurred. Wendy seconded the motion. The motion passed. Wendy agreed to research the options before purchases were made.

Wendy made a motion to pay for three new picnic tables for Williams Park totaling \$370.47. Pam seconded the motion. The motion passed. The tables are already in Williams Park.
