Meeting called to order 5:40

Attending: Dick Dale, Bruce Frauman, George Mora, Paul Gordon sitting in

Dick moved to approve agenda, George seconded...approved

Bruce moved to approve minutes, Dick seconded...approved

Short discussion to clarify suggestion to approach the Holt sisters for fundraising.

Brief discussion of Phase 2 Form; contents good, could use an organizational brushing up (George will do). Dick moved to approve content, George seconded; approved.

Discussion of which homeowners to target in first batch mailing; agreed to use 'full-time residents' rather than 'homesteaders'.

Debated whether to hand out forms at Town Meeting (yes); Other opportunities could be A) whatever event replaces the Valentine's dance, B) Tax Bill mailing, C) Farmer's Market, D) Harvest Dinner

Made a plan for distribution at Town Meeting; Need to get permission from (? Kelly?). Dick to approach those who offered to Volunteer on Phase 1 Form for assistance

Will decide on mailing after Town Meeting

Can go back to rescue groups once we have a demonstrated response

In autumn, we can approach Thrifty Attic for grant money

Long discussion of Mighty Londonderry Facebook page. Seen as a positive that there were 270 members, with the majority of posting positive and civil. Trying to find a way to keep the forum open. Dick suggested removing any reference to CRO, strengthening the disclaimer, perhaps changing the name to something other than Mighty Londonderry. All agree that it would need more attentive moderation. Agreement to leave it 'dormant' for the time being.

Dick raised the question about the long-term viability of the CRO if the Inventory project fails to gain traction.
